Elementary Education Adjunct Professors for University Supervisors of Field Experience or/and Student Teaching

Elementary Education Program in the Department of Teacher Preparation at Roosevelt University is seeking Adjunct Professors to supervise Field Experience students and student teachers in elementary settings (1st to 6th grade) in the role of University Supervisor. University Supervisors teaches weekly seminars (via zoom), observes students and/or student teachers in their school placements, communicates with cooperating teachers, and provides other support as necessary. University Supervisor meets face to face or on Zoom with cooperating teachers to orient them to the expectations for field experience students or student teachers and after each observation of a field student or a student teacher.

For Field Experience supervisor observes each student twice over the 15-week semester and provides timely feedback after each observation. Field Experience supervisor provides two Modified Danielson Teaching Rubric during the semester and Educator Disposition Assessment.

Student Teaching University Supervisor observes each student teacher four times over the 15-week student teaching and provides timely feedback after each observation. University Supervisor provides two summative evaluations of student teacher performance using program-approved evaluation form (Modified Danielson Framework for Teaching) and completes an end-of-semester evaluation of professional dispositions.

University Supervisor must hold a master's degree (or higher) in Elementary Education and have a record of successful teaching in elementary education setting for a minimum of three to five years.
