Special Education Adjunct Professor for University Supervisor of Student Teaching

Special Education Program in the Department of Teacher Preparation at Roosevelt University is seeking Adjunct Professors to supervise student teachers in special education settings in the role of University Supervisor. University Supervisor teaches weekly seminars (via zoom), observes student teachers in their school placements, communicates with cooperating teachers, and provides other support as necessary. University Supervisor meets face to face or on Zoom with cooperating teachers to orient them to the expectations for student teachers and after each observation of a student teacher. University Supervisor observes each student teacher four times over the 15-week student teaching and provides timely feedback after each observation. University Supervisor provides two summative evaluations of student teacher performance using program-approved evaluation form (Modified Danielson Framework for Teaching) and completes an end-of-semester evaluation of professional dispositions.

University Supervisor must hold a master's degree (or higher) in special education and have a record of successful teaching in special education setting for a minimum of five years.
